On March 23, 2020, Michigan Governor Whitmer issued Executive Order No. 2020-21, "Temporary requirement to suspend activities that are not necessary to sustain or protect life" in which she mandated that "No person or entity shall operate a business or conduct operations that require workers to leave their homes or places of residence except to the extent that those workers are necessary to sustain or protect life or to conduct minimum basic operations." To provide further guidance and definition of "critical infrastructure workers", she referenced the CISA listed **ESSENTIAL CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE WORKERS DURING COVID-19 RESPONSE** issued on March 19, 2020. This order applies to all residents and businesses within the State of Michigan and includes Insulspan's Blissfield, MI operations.

Upon review of both Executive Order No. 2020-21 as well as the CISA listed document, we have determined that the operations of Insulspan support several named segments. Specifically, those segments include Healthcare/Public Health, Food and Agriculture, Transportation and Logistics and Critical Manufacturing. Further, in conversations with our customers, we have been notified that our products and services are instrumental in their ability to fulfill their obligations to support critical infrastructure in those industries.

Insulspan is committed to maintaining the ongoing safe operations of our facility to support our nation's communities as we work together to meet fulfill our critical infrastructure requirements during these challenging times. Further we understand the parameters in which those operations must be maintained and have taken the steps required in the Order to be in compliance.

To that end, based on our understanding of known, local, state and federal guidelines, Insulspan through its distribution channels is considered Essential Business, exempt from shelter in place executive orders, permitting us to maintain operations within applicable guidelines. We will continue to monitor and review new guidelines as well as work in conjunction with applicable governmental authorities to ensure that they support our endeavors to remain open in a manner that meets the needs of our communities, customers, employees and suppliers.
